REGISTRATION FOR 2010-2011

REGISTRATION FOR SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

Registration for first penance, first Holy Communion and confirmation is taking place. A child must have been in faith formation or a Catholic school this past year in order to

receive a sacrament in the 2010-2011 school year. Children from private schools outside of St. Jane must register with the Faith Formation Office in order to receive a sacrament at St. Jane. U. S. BISHOPS LAUNCH VOCATIONS WEBSITE
